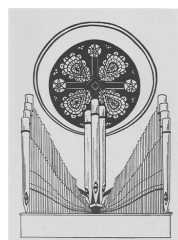

The immediate concern is that the Gemshorn, one of the stops in the Antiphonal Organ, is ON all the time. The cost for re-actioning just this one stop is \$1000.
